

## 2010 T H S R A STATE FINALS

In Addition To The 2008-2010 RULE BOOK OF THE NHSRA & THSRA,  
Plus GROUND RULES From The National Office, The Following Will Be  
Ground Rules At The 2010 THSRA STATE FINALS - Abilene, Texas -  
June 11 - 20, 2010

- 1) **All contestants** must bring either their final report card for the 2009-10 school year, transcript for the 2009-10 school year, or a letter from their school (**on school stationary, with school seal**) listing their Spring Semester Grades or a letter stating that the contestant has passed at least four (4) subjects. The letter must be signed by a **school counselor, principal or superintendent. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO CHECK IN WITHOUT ONE OF THESE DOCUMENTS. NO ONE WILL BE ABLE TO HAVE GRADES FAXED AFTER 1:00 PM SUNDAY, JUNE 13th - this will be when check-in is over.**
  - 2) Any contestant having a problem making the check-in time on Sunday, June 13th, needs to call this office (936)248-4325 ASAP. The only excuse for being late to check-in has to be school related.
  - 3) Campers and/or horses cannot be brought in and left on grounds or in stalls before **Saturday morning, June 12th, 2010, starting at 7:00 AM.** Only exception will be Queen Contestants. As contestants arrive, they will be taken to their assigned stalls and shown where to park their trailers by Expo personnel and Taylor County officials. Any contestant refusing to do so will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to park their living quarter trailer and/or non living quarter trailer on the grounds.
  - 4) All non living quarter trailers will be parked on the South/West section of the grounds.
  - 5) Any contestant planning to stay on the grounds must bring their own water hoses and extension cords for trailers, and contestants with horses must bring their own fans, extension cords for fans, and water hoses.
  - 6) Each contestant staying on grounds will be issued one (1) parking pass. Contestants may purchase a second pass for \$50.00. Only vehicles with a parking pass will be allowed on the grounds. There will be no more than two (2) passes issued per contestant. Any other vehicles will be parked in the coliseum parking areas and use the walk thru gates. Contestants/family members staying off premises do not have the privilege of purchasing any additional passes.

- 7) **Dress Code**
    - A. Inside Coliseum - full dress (hats, boots, long sleeves, and back #s on back)
    - B. Horse Barn (Barn #3 on map) full dress sitting in the stands and while competing While in the stall area of horse barn, back # must be on back.
    - C. Outdoor Arena (Arena #5 on map) full dress sitting in the stands and while competing in the rodeo.
  - 8) **Alcohol and Drugs**
    - A. No tolerance for alcohol consumption and/or drugs or in presence of alcohol and/or drugs.
    - B. Automatic trip home.
  - 9) **Cruising Around in Vehicles**
    - A. Thirty (30) minutes after the rodeo is over, during dances, and during the day light hours there will be no "just driving around" in any form of vehicle.
    - B. Speed limit signs will be posted and must be complied with.

10) Non-Licensed Vehicles

There will be no scooters, bicycles, tricycles, mules or 4-wheelers allowed on the grounds without prior written approval of the Executive Board.

11) "Saving" RV Spaces

No vehicle may park in areas where RV hookups are located. There will be no "saving" of RV spaces for your friends or family etc. If you want to park by someone, you must arrive there together.

12) Electrical Panels

No contestant and/or family member should attempt to work on any electrical panel on the facility. Should problems arise, please notify the main office or rodeo secretary, and a licensed electrician will take care of any issue. If this is not adhered to, you will be asked to leave the grounds with your RV and/or horse.
